


Technical Tour

Join us for a Technical Tour to the Port of Narvik, the iron-ore shipping facilities and on a railway journey along the Heavy Haul line – Ofofbanen - from Narvik to the Swedish border. The tour will take place the day after the conference on June 15th 2019.


About the Technical Tour

The Tour will start with a visit to LKAB's terminal in the heart of Narvik. The 650m long unloading station has been designed and developed for high capacity and environmentally efficient delivery. The unloading station is powered by advanced automation, enabling an ore train carrying 6.800 tonnes of iron-ore products to be unloaded in 30 minutes. The train's 68 bottom dumper wagons release the ore into 60 m deep underground silos. You will also be able to visit the ship loading facilities.



S/S «Uppland» was the first iron-ore ship to leave Narvik in January 1903.

After visiting LKAB we will take the bus 1,5 km south of Narvik to the combined freight and ore terminal called Narvikterminalen. Here you will see the unloading station for the Helix Dumper wagons used by Kaunis Iron and visit their ship loading facilities.



The second part of the tour brings us out of Narvik, by train, along the Heavy Haul line – Ofofbanen - from Narvik to the Swedish border. Ofofbanen is, by some, referred to as one of the most spectacular railway lines in the world. Allow yourself to be taken in by the magnificent landscape of fjords and mountains.

We will learn the history of Ofofbanen, but also how it is run today, the technical challenges and the plans for the future. Lunch will be served at Katterat station.

The tour will depart from the city centre at 8.30am, and we will arrive back in Narvik at 16.30 (4.30pm).

An additional option – A hike along the Navvy road.

We will also give you an exciting additional option – a 6 km hike with a guide along the old construction road from Katterat station down to Rombaksbotn (the settlement where the navvies lived when working on the railway). After the historical hike down to the fjord, you will enjoy a light meal before returning by RIB/boat to Sildvik (passing the ship wreck of the German destroyer Georg Thiele) and bus back to Narvik at 21.00 (9pm). We recommend clothes and footwear suitable for hiking under different weather conditions.
